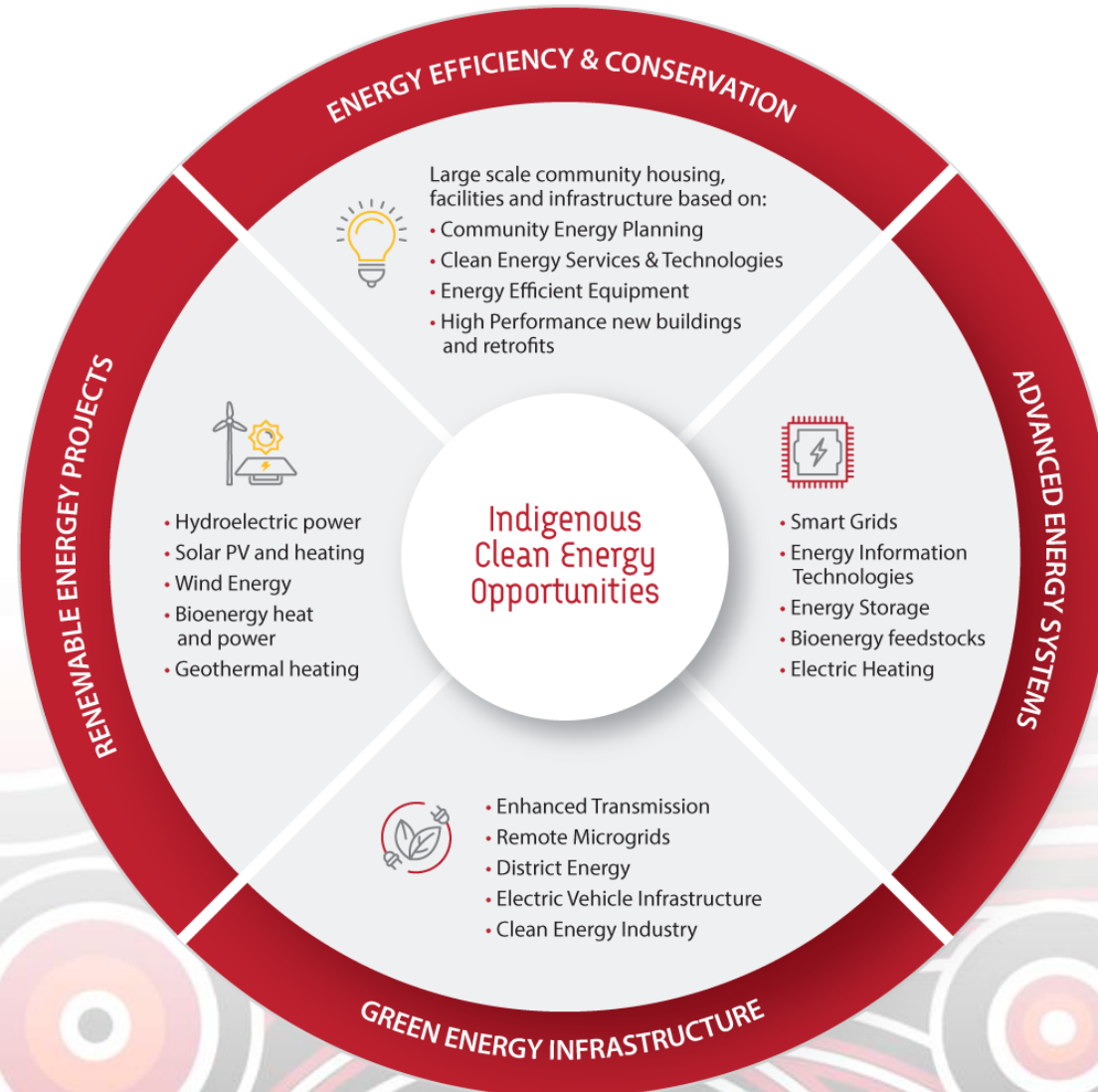

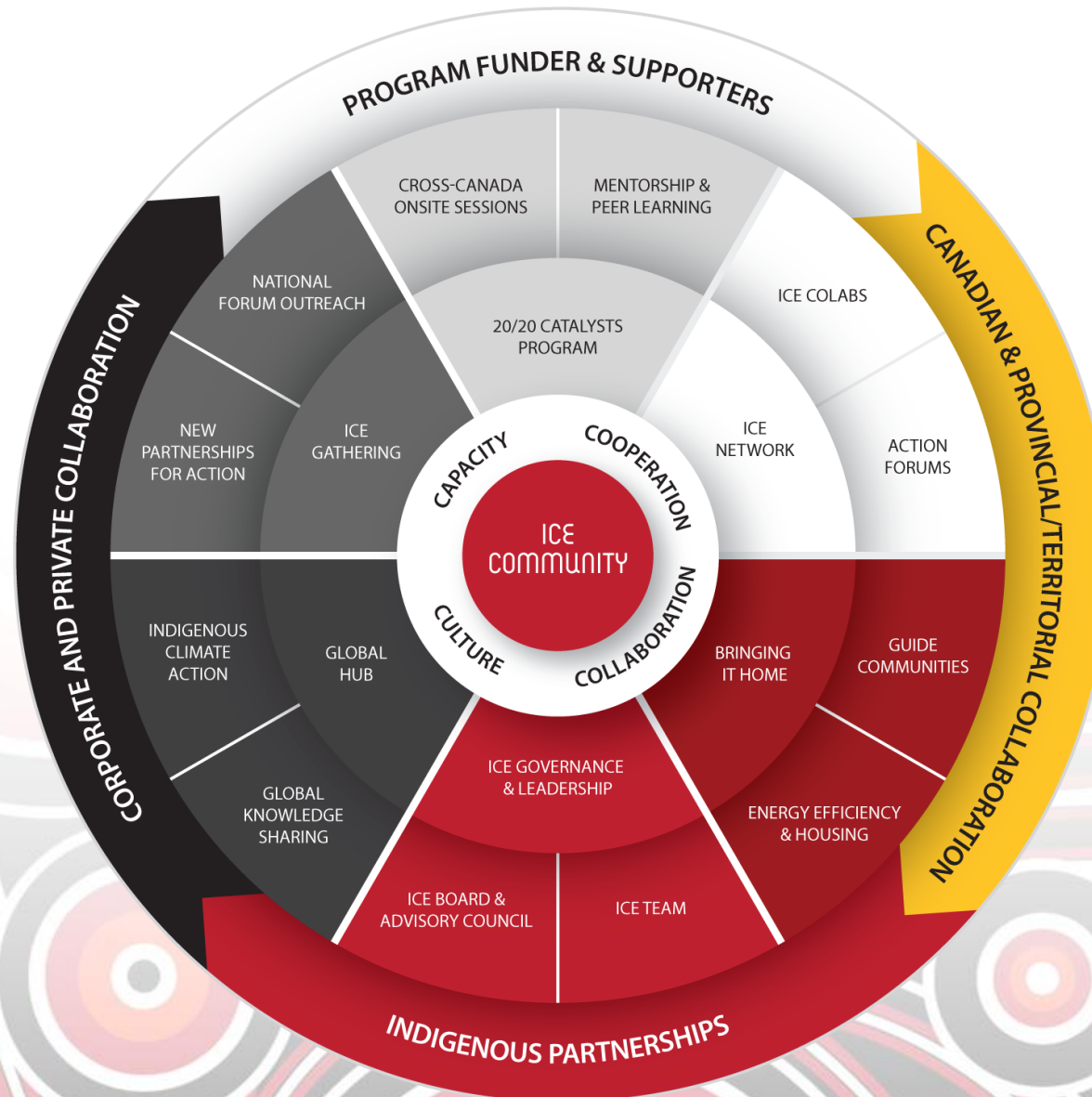
Braiding Sweetgrass

In her spellbinding book Braiding Sweetgrass, Robin Wall Kimmerer of the Potawatomi Nation writes of how her “braid of stories is woven from three strands: indigenous ways of knowing, scientific knowledge, and the story of an Anisihnabek scientist”. She goes further and expresses that “wiingaaashk, or sweetgrass is a powerful ceremonial plant cherished by many Indigenous nations ... its value both material and spiritual.”

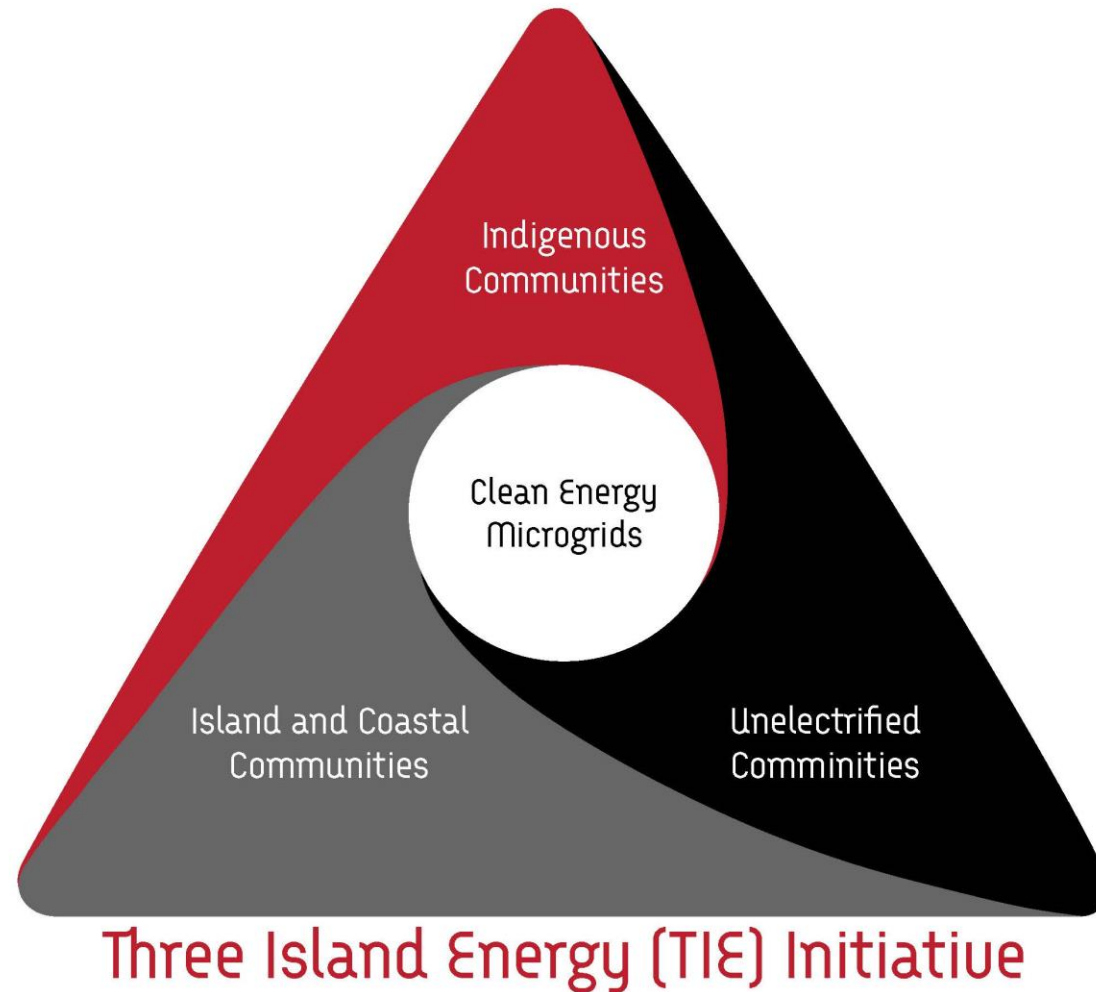
